	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Tax research</b> The event to be held on 26<sup>th</sup> November has been postponed to 10<sup>th</sup> September 2014, with a view to findings contributing to a book which will be a benchmark of where taxation is at now. This is to be edited by Chris Evans, Karen and Andy and published in early 2015. It will also form the basis of a pdf document which can be widely circulated for free. Rajiv Prabhakar is working with Karen and Andy to devise some questions to place on an omnibus survey to test public opinion on attitudes to taxation</li> <li>• <b>Financial education event</b> This will be held on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2014 with invited international speakers. 10 key people have already confirmed attendance. The event will be the basis of future collaboration, publications and proposals.</li> <li>• <b>INRAP</b> The website is to go 'live' at the end of January 2014.</li> <li>• <b>Internships</b> Up to 3 undergraduate internships, (all years and recent graduates), will be funded from the Andrew Fisher budget. Applications will be considered by Karen and Andy and interviews will be held. They will be supervised by a member of CHASM, depending on where their project interest lies.</li> <li>• <b>Conference attendance</b> A number of conferences were attended, funded by the Andrew Fisher budget. And a list of these is to be maintained. Further funding from Andrew Fisher is to be applied for, which will fund Karen, Ricky, Lindsey and Jose's time, and also further conference attendance and the wealth tax event.
