Fees

The cost of the pre-Masters year (Year 1) for 2014–2015 is £12,565. Fees for the Masters programme (Year 2) are set at the standard rate for postgraduate courses (please see individual programmes). Please visit our website for the latest information.

Entry requirements

These two-year programmes – Masters Degree with Integrated pre-Masters – are suitable for students who do not meet the entry requirements for the one year masters courses in the fields

of Music, Biosciences and Economics.

Applicants with a recognised first degree/diploma (in a relevant subject area for Biosciences and Music) will be eligible for consideration.

For the Economics programmes, applicants with a recognised first degree (in an unrelated subject area with some mathematical content) will be eligible for consideration. To find country-specific entry requirements, visit:
