

## Entry requirements



To be accepted onto the Birmingham International Summer School you must:

Be studying an undergraduate programme at a University outside the UK or be registered as an International student at a UK university

Be of good academic standing (based on a transcript or letter of recommendation from your University provided during the application process).

Students applying for the Mathematical Finance and Financial Time Series Analysis programme need to have prerequisites of calculus, probability and statistics, or have the equivalent level of knowledge.

Students applying for Sport: Molecules & Muscles to Money should have studied biology at A level or equivalent ( level 12 is also acceptable), or currently studying on a science degree.

- Have achieved proficiency in English Language equivalent to IELTS 5.5 overall with no lower than 5.0 in any band.\*
