

Beijing Alumni Informal Gathering - 8 September 2011

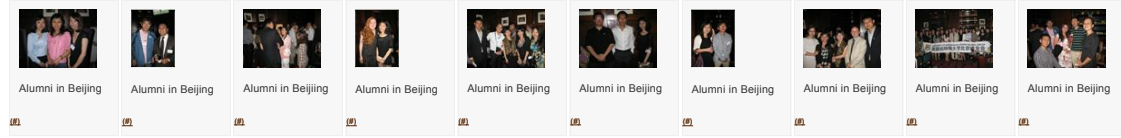
