The campaign features three notable alumni sport stars who have achieved fantastic results whilst being supported by the University.

Our alumni heroes are: 1500m world silver medalist and Olympic hopeful Hannah England (BSc Biochemistry, 2009), Paralympic track hopeful Dean Miller (BA Sport and Physical Education, 2011) and para-cyclist Lora Turnham (BSc Physiotherapy, 2010).
