Birmingham Contemporary Music Group performs two classics of 20th-century music - Schoenberg's **Pierrot lunaire**, premiered 100 years ago, in which the moonstruck naïf of Albert Giraud's poems half-speaks, half-sings of love, religion, violence and homesickness; and Olivier Messiaen's **Quatuor pour la fin du temps** (Quartet for the End of Time), a piece that with its grandly singing lines and gently ringing chords stops time with each performance.
