Birmingham Guide Dogs for the Blind will be on campus as part of the University's Focus on Disability and will be hosting a **stall in the Muirhead Tower Foyer** (</events/disability-focus/Talks/guide-dogs-for-the-blind-exhibition.aspx>) from 2nd-6th December.



They will also be running two drop-in workshops, open to all, to provide an insight into the daily life of people with vision impairments, as well as training on how to approach and guide someone who has an impairment.
