Her book traces human origins from Africa through our colonisation of the globe; using scientific methods, from climatology to genetics, whilst exploring art, culture and society, she encourages us to ask some of the great questions in life: who are we, and how did we get here? The book has been chosen for its cross-disciplinary appeal - spanning areas such as geology, anthropology and archaeology.
