### The Sixteen: An Immortal Legacy

World renowned choir The Sixteen bring one of their most popular concert programmes, celebrating the lasting legacy of sixteenth century composers and their influence on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> century composers, to the Barber.

This concert features some of the best-loved classics of Tudor and Jacobean church music together with madrigals by Tallis, Byrd and Gibbons, alongside pieces by Britten, Tippett and MacMillan including the 'Five Spirituals' from *A Child of Our Time* and the 'Choral Dances' from *Gloriana*.
