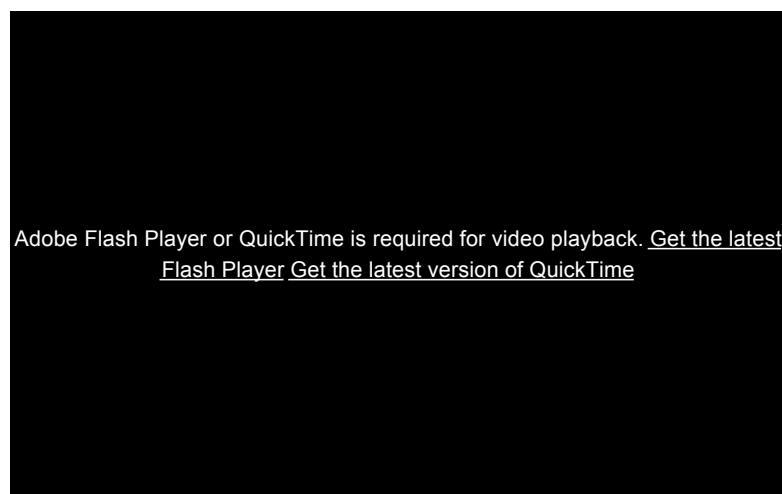
The Languages for All team of the University of Birmingham offers the following languages at up to eight levels:

This will involve more than language for tourism, as it is hoped a sound basis of linguistic skills will enable participants to continue their language learning at higher levels in subsequent years.

Practical language classes (maximum number of 16) involve both whole-group and small-group/pair-work activities, with the emphasis on oral communication. Use is made of visual aids, audio and video recordings, and computer-based materials.
