Their role involves liaison with Principal Investigators and other members of the multidisciplinary team to develop and manage trial protocols to ensure a high quality of data collection, ensuring participant safety and welfare. They are also responsible for the effective running of the Clinical Research Facility in the absence of their line manager.

A career within clinical research nursing also offers opportunities to train for extended roles which include venepuncture, cannulation and administration of chemotherapy.
