

## NHS Athens account

NHS Evidence is a web based collection of resources that is free for all NHS staff. To access it you need to create an **NHS Athens account**.

Use an NHS computer to speed up the registration process and your details will be emailed to you immediately.

### Services available via NHS Evidence

With your NHS Athens account set up you can access **ejournals** (<http://www.library.nhs.uk/booksandjournals/journals/default.aspx>) and **databases** (<http://www.library.nhs.uk/login.aspx?postloginpage=/booksandjournals/advanced/default.aspx>) and set up **Zetoc alerts** (<http://zetoc.mimas.ac.uk/>) and **Search Autoalerts** (<http://www.library.nhs.uk/login.aspx?postloginpage=/booksandjournals/advanced/default.aspx>).

### Forgotten password

If you've forgotten your password, go to the **login page** (<http://www.library.nhs.uk/login.aspx>) and select 'Forgot your password?'. Enter your username or email address, and you'll be sent an email with a link to reset your password.

### Forgotten username

If you have forgotten your username you will need to contact your local NHS Athens administrator. You can **email them** (<http://www.library.nhs.uk/athens/admin>) or ask at your local NHS library. They will know who your administrator is.

### Change of job or trust

If you have changed your job and now work for a different trust you may have to update your NHS Athens account. This may be done automatically for you by your local administrator or it may not. To be sure contact your local NHS library either by **email** (<http://www.library.nhs.uk/athens/admin>) or in person and they will put you in touch with the administrator.
