JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

The coach will arrive at the Main Entrance to the University, the East Gate (see map below) at 08:10 and will depart at 08:30 (or as soon as everyone is on board). Because we have a very full programme we must depart by 08:30 and we will not be able to wait for anyone who is delayed. If you will be bringing luggage then please inform the organisers and please arrive in time for us to pack the coach.

The usb-stick that you will receive at registration contains a copy of the Excursion Guidebook and you will also receive a printed copy on the coach. We will be providing morning refreshments and a packed lunch with special arrangements for those who have informed us of their dietary requirements.

You will be walking for about 5km over rough terrain and are advised to wear boots or strong shoes. English weather is notoriously unpredictable, even in June, so on the evening of the 25th you are advised to check the weather forecast for Castleton using www.bbc.co.uk/weather/forecast and wear / bring appropriate clothing.

The last stop on the Excursion (before returning to the University) will be at Matlock Bath railway station from where there are hourly trains to Derby with onwards connections to Birmingham International Airport (total journey time from Matlock Bath 2 hours) and Manchester International Airport (total journey time from Matlock Bath 3 hours) as well as to other destinations. From Matlock Bath the coach will return directly to the University East Gate, aiming to arrive by 20:30.
