Zebrafish community talk, King's College London – 21 October 2016

“A new look at ZFIN mRNA *in-situ* hybridisation data”

In the October meeting of the Zebrafish Community, London, Dunja presented part of her PhD work to a wide variety of zebrafish researchers mainly based at Kings College London and University College London. In this talk Dunja explained her work on analysis of ZFIN curated data on mRNA *in situ* hybridisation. She showed how current information about gene expression on ZFIN has miss-annotations and how care should be taken when browsing their data. Additionally, she presented how after filtering this data she used comprehensive information obtained from the whole ZFIN it to select genes for enhancer trap lines.
