The **Education Library** (<https://intranet.birmingham.ac.uk/as/libraryservices/library/about/libraries/education.aspx>), houses key texts for taught courses and research material for all aspects of Education, focusing on material for the four research groups within the School

- Disability, Inclusion and Special Needs
- Education and Social Justice
- Language Discourse and Society
- Professional Learning and Development

The Education Library also holds an eclectic collection of Education pamphlets which are currently being catalogued and added to the online catalogue. This collection mostly contains material from the 1940's through to the 1970's and contains some diverse material, from inaugural lectures at various Schools of Education across the country to paraphernalia from the Scout movement.
