

## Four University of Birmingham staff recognised in New Year's Honours

Pro-Chancellor and chair of the University of Birmingham and former chair of the Student Loans Company, [Ed Smith \(/council/membership/ed-smith.aspx\)](/council/membership/ed-smith.aspx), has been awarded a CBE for services to higher education in the New Year's Honours.

Mr Smith, who heads the University's supreme governing body, is one of four University of Birmingham staff and associates recognised in the 2014 New Year's Honours list.

British Empire Medals were awarded to [Dr Simon Cotton \(/staff/profiles/chemistry/cotton-simon.aspx\)](/staff/profiles/chemistry/cotton-simon.aspx), honorary senior lecturer in Chemistry, for services to Chemistry, and Sylvia Gardiner, digital assets assistant, Library Services, for services to higher education and charitable services in Ethiopia through a charity she founded called [Lucia \(http://www.luciacharity.org.uk\)](http://www.luciacharity.org.uk) – Life Uplifted by Change in Africa.

Congratulating the four, Professor David Eastwood, Vice-Chancellor of the University of Birmingham, said: "We are delighted that the hard work and dedication of so many of our staff and associates has been recognised in this way.
