#### Transfers

### Applications for academic year 2015/16

Applications for accommodation for academic year 2015/16 are **now open (/postgraduate/accommodation/Apply-for-accommodation/apply.aspx)**. You can login and apply for accommodation as long as you have had an offer of a place to study at Birmingham. You will require a Student ID number, which will be included in your offer letter, to apply.

If you have applied for a previous year's accommodation and have then deferred entry, you will **need to reapply** for accommodation for the 2015/16 session.

### Right to Rent Checks

Following recent government legislation, landlords in the West Midlands will now be required to check a tenant's right to be in the UK before allowing them to live in their property. This applies to any new tenancy in private rented accommodation starting after 1st December 2014. Therefore if you are looking to rent property in the private sector, even if you are a UK citizen, you can expect your landlord to ask to see (and take copies of) documents that confirm your right to be in the UK.
