- Have developed a thorough knowledge and understanding of a particular issue in Russian and East European Studies
- Be able to identify, evaluate and critique the existing body of literature on the subject
- Be able to deliver a presentation (using visual aids)

Assessment

- One 4,500-word assessed essay (80%)
- One assessed oral presentation (20%)
