One-off award of £2,000 for full-time home/EU students, and £3,000 for full-time overseas students. The value of the award will be adjusted pro-rata for part-time students.

Eligibility Criteria

These bursaries are open to students applying for full-time or part-time distance learning PhD, MA by Research or MRes programmes, worldwide.
