

## Launch of online Coptic transcriptions

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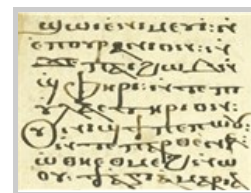
The **International Greek New Testament project** (<http://www.igntp.org/>) has now added transcriptions of the minor Coptic versions of the Gospel according to John to its online transcripts site.

The transcriptions of the Achmimic, Middle Egyptian, Middle Egyptian Fayumic and Fayumic were prepared for the IGNTF by Dr Christian Askeland and three collaborators.
