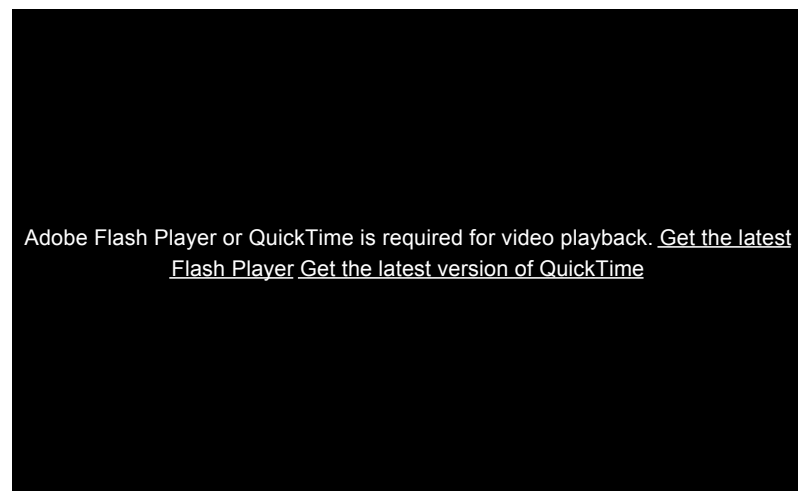


## Videos of ITSEE members talking about their work

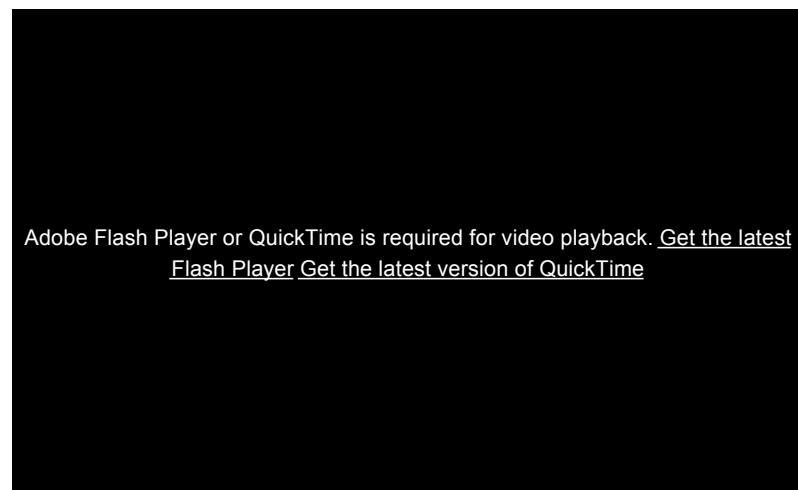
Videos are now available on the University's YouTube channel of several members of ITSEE talking about their work.

Doctoral student Edgar Ebojo introduces his research on P46, a papyrus codex of the Pauline Epistles:



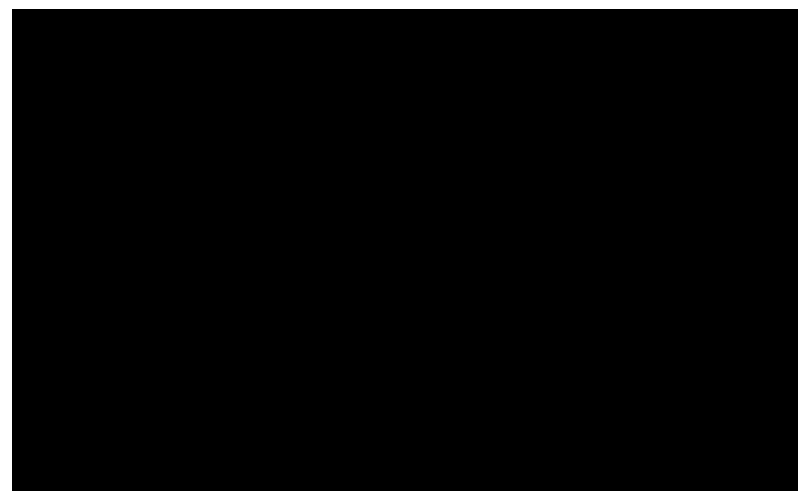
