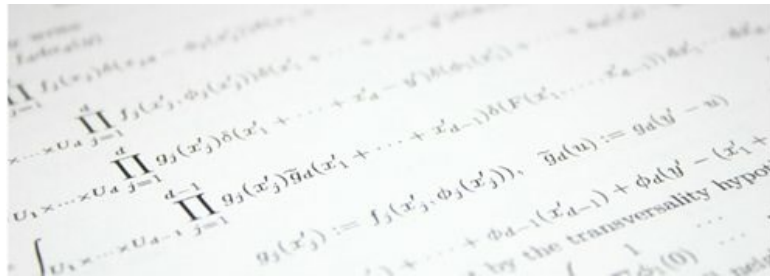


Pure Mathematics Research

The Pure Mathematics Group has internationally renowned research groups in [algebra](/research/activity/mathematics/pure-maths/algebra.aspx), [analysis](/research/activity/mathematics/pure-maths/analysis.aspx) and [combinatorics](/research/activity/mathematics/pure-maths/combinatorics.aspx). In the last Research Assessment Exercise (RAE 2008) over half of our research outputs were rated as world-leading or internationally excellent.
