- Judging of school wide 'Inventions' competition. The announcement of winners to be made during assembly, if the ambassador was happy to attend at this time.
- Session with Year 5 & 6 where ambassadors will talk about their career in Science. This could be in the form of a presentation, followed by a question and answer session.

The sessions will run on one or two of these days during this week, depending on the availability of ambassadors.
