- Study Biological Sciences or Biotechnology for the first 2 years at Fudan University or HZAU
 - Study for the next 2 years in the School of Biosciences at the University of Birmingham, UK
- Graduate with a Bachelor or Masters degree awarded by the University of Birmingham which will be recognised by Fudan University or HZAU

The programmes at Birmingham

- Students can study either Biological Sciences or Biochemistry
- We offer a wide choice of specialist modules which allow students to follow their own interests
