Birmingham Business School offers a number of scholarships for students on the MSc Business programmes to reward outstanding academic achievement. The financial support offered is to contribute towards tuition fees. These awards are based on merit and will be selected by a panel of representatives from the Business School.

The awards are available for students who are nationals of the following countries/regions:

UK /EU	3	5,000
South East Asia	3	5,000

All eligible applicants who are offered a place on one of the 12 month MSc Business programmes listed to the right will be considered for the above scholarships, provided:

You have been made an offer of study before the cut-off date. These dates are:

- International students: **13 April 2015**, UK/EU students: **29 June 2015**

You complete the application form and then submit it electronically. A link to the application form will be sent automatically to eligible students after the cut-off date. Applications to be submitted by:

- International students: **1 June 2015**, UK/EU students: **20 July 2015**

Successful students will be informed of their award by:

- International students: **29 June 2015** UK/EU students: **10 August 2015**

Successful students must not be in receipt of any other University of Birmingham scholarship, or a full scholarship from any other source, in order to take up the award.

## University of Birmingham and Jamaica National Foundation Legacy Scholarship



In order to be an eligible scholarship candidate, applicants must have applied for and been made an offer to study on one of the following 12-month MSc programmes at Birmingham Business School, University of Birmingham starting in September 2014; MSc International Accounting and Finance, MSc Investments, MSc Financial Management, MSc International Business, MSc Human Resource Management, MSc Human Resource Management (With CIPD Pathway), MSc Management, MSc Marketing, MSc International Marketing, MSc Marketing Communications, MSc Strategic Marketing and Consulting, MSc Development Economics, MSc Economics, MSc International Economics, MSc Environmental and Natural Resource Economics, MSc

Mathematical Finance, MSc Money Banking and Finance, MSc International Money and Banking, MSc Financial Economics. This offer needs to be made by the University of Birmingham by 30th April 2014 at the latest.

- Candidates must also be a Jamaican citizen by birth, must reside in Jamaica at the time of the scholarship application, and graduated any accredited Jamaican university within the last two years.
- On 1st May 2014 eligible scholarship candidates will be emailed a link to an online scholarship application form. The form must be completed and submitted to Birmingham Business School by 27th May 2014 at the latest. The online application form will include a section for personal details plus a free text box where candidates will be invited to provide a personal statement (maximum 1,000 words) indicating why they should be awarded the scholarship.
- The Business School's Scholarship Committee and JNBS will consider the applications received, and interviews will be held in Jamaica for those shortlisted.
- The successful candidate will be announced on 1st July 2014.
- The scholarship will cover tuition fees, accommodation costs, a maintenance element, an economy return flight, work experience arranged by JNBS, and potentially additional funding for athletic development (all subject to terms and conditions).
