Module-based Masters Degree in Advanced General Dental Practice

As part of its programme to promote stronger interactions between the School of Dentistry and general dental practitioners, the University of Birmingham runs a Masters Degree in Advanced General Dental Practice.

This qualification is based on a series of 20 credit modules, which can be taken part-time over a period of two years. The course includes 60 credits of core modules, the successful completion of which will result in a Postgraduate Higher Education Certificate in General Dental Practice. The successful finishing of a further three modules then leads to a Postgraduate Higher Education Diploma.

For the award of the full Master's degree, students will additionally present a clinical case project and an audit project, which will complete their studies.
