

Radical Shakespeare Teaching Roundtable at the Shakespeare Institute

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On Thursday 21 June 2012 a Radical Shakespeare Teaching Roundtable was held at the [Shakespeare Institute \(/schools/edacs/departments/shakespeare/index.aspx\)](http://schools.edacs/departments/shakespeare/index.aspx).
