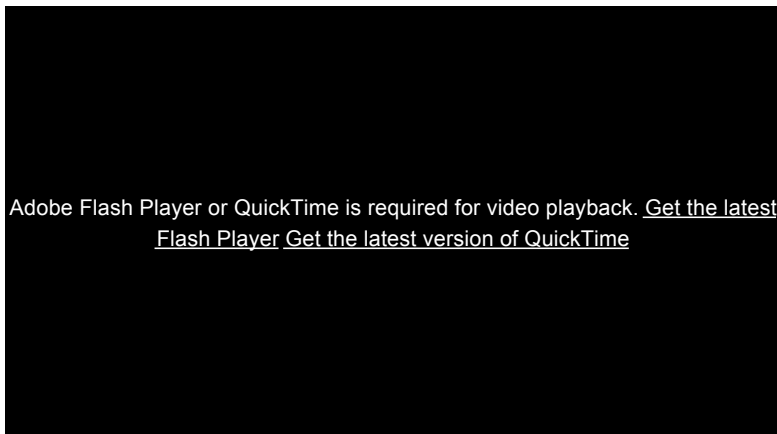

This guarantee is subject to the following conditions:

You must have firmly accepted the offer of a place on a Birmingham programme of study

Your application for accommodation must be received by our Accommodation Services Office no later than 31 July 2014

- You must be applying for accommodation for one person. The University also has a limited supply of accommodation for students wishing to bring their families to Birmingham. - You agree to remain in your University accommodation for the full term of your contract.
