Adrian Blackledge is Director of the [MOSAIC Centre for Research on Multilingualism \(/research/activity/education/mosaic/index.aspx\)](#). He is author of numerous articles and books based on his research on multilingualism in education and wider society. His books include *Heteroglossia as Practice and Pedagogy* (2014); *The Routledge Handbook of Multilingualism* (2012); *Multilingualism. A Critical Perspective* (2010); *Discourse and Power in a Multilingual World* (2005); *Negotiation of Identities in Multilingual Contexts* (2004); *Multilingualism, Second Language Learning, and Gender* (2001); and *Literacy, Power, and Social Justice* (2000).

In recent years Adrian has been awarded more than £3 million in research council funding. He is currently engaged in a project funded through the AHRC *Translating Cultures* theme, 'Translation and Translanguaging: Investigating Linguistic and Cultural Transformations in Superdiverse Wards in Four UK Cities' (Principal Investigator: Professor Angela Creese - see the Translation and Translanguaging website to find out more).
