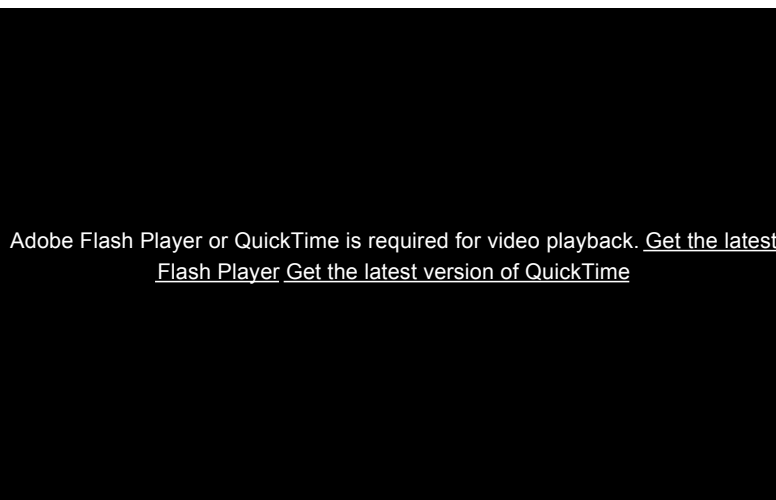



## Alumni
