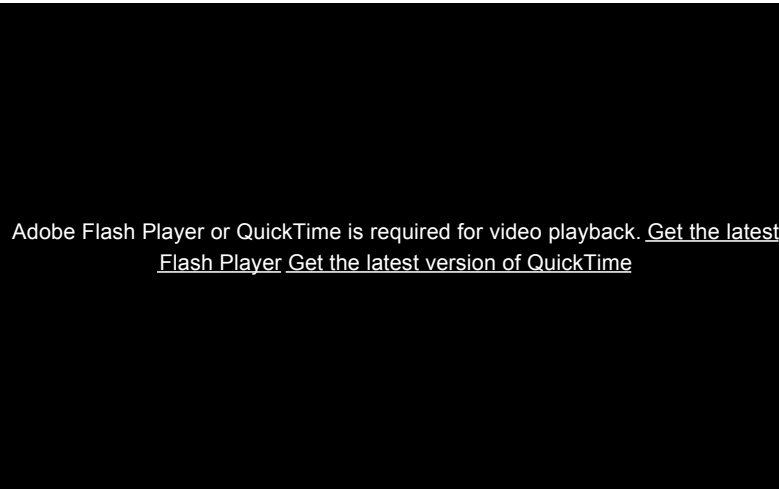


Politics Society Alumni Roundtable event

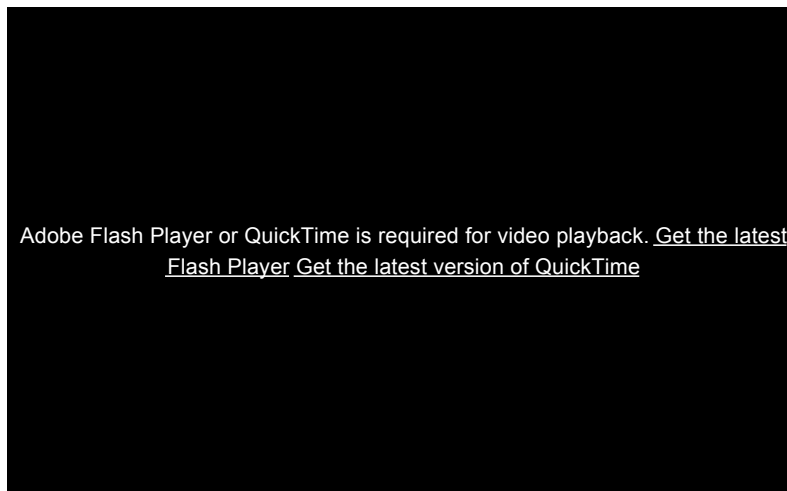
