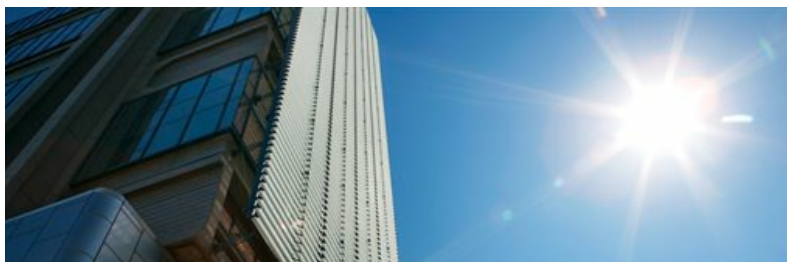


## Visits and open days
