Recently, Nikolaos was appointed Adjunct Professor at the School of Nursing, Faculty of Health Sciences of the University of Ottawa.

Nikolaos has a clinical background in Critical Care and maintains his clinical activity by working closely with NHS partners to undertake research and apply findings in nursing practice.

Biography

Nikolaos Efstathiou qualified with a degree in Nursing from the Technological Educational Institute of Athens in 1992. After completing 18 months of compulsory military service in a nursing capacity, he was awarded a grant from the Institution of Greek State Scholarships (I.K.Y) to study for an MSc in UK. In 1996, he started working as a critical care nurse in a busy Intensive Care Unit in Athens. While working he continued studying part time for his PhD, which was completed in 2004.

The last ten years, he is working as a nursing lecturer in Higher Educational Institutions in UK. Main areas of teaching include critical care nursing, anatomy and physiology, End of Life care and research methods. Being interested in improving the student's experience in the classroom, he has developed skills in simulated inter-professional teaching and the use of Audience Response System.

End-of-Life care has become his research interest since he completed his PhD which explored healthcare providers and users' perceptions of oncology care provision. He is also collaborating with research nurses at the Trauma Research Trials Unit (University Hospital of Birmingham NIHR Surgical Reconstruction and Microbiology Research Centre) to develop research that will improve further trauma patients' care.
