### Entrance requirements

- For the LLM programmes we require a 2:1 in a UK Law degree or overseas equivalent, we will also consider students with a high 2:2 if supported by strong references.
- We consider students with a 2:1 or equivalent from non-law backgrounds only if there is also substantial legal experience.
- For the MA programme we require a 2:1 in a related subject area such as politics, philosophy or law.

### English language requirements

If your first language is not English you must provide an English language

qualification. Recognised qualifications are:

#### IELTS:

- 7.0 with no less than 6.5 in any band

If you need to improve your level of English in order to meet the minimum entry-level requirement you may be able attend one of the full-time courses run by our [English for International Students Unit \(/undergraduate/courses/presessional/index.aspx\)](#).
