Entrance requirements

Undergraduate programmes

- Holders of the KCSE (Kenyan Certificate of Secondary Education) and a suitable foundation programme will be considered for entry to our undergraduate degree programmes.

Postgraduate programmes

- 2:1 or equivalent in an LLB degree from a recognised institution. We will also consider high 2:2 grades when supported by strong references.

Graduate-entry programmes

- 2:1 or equivalent in any degree programme from a recognised institution. We will also consider high 2:2 grades when supported by strong references.
