

LLM Law and Business of Project Finance

Module description:

This module will look at where project finance is used and why it presents an alternative to other financing options. The module will consider risk identification, mitigation and allocation via project finance contracts, issues with cross border projects and the variety of project finance structures. Using case studies, we will explore technical, political and economic issues in project financing in the UK and further afield. We will look at the management of environmental risks and the use of the Equator Principles. Finally, we will consider a variety of dispute resolution mechanisms deployed in the project finance arena. This module will draw heavily on real world projects.

Methods of assessment
