The School incorporates the Department of [History of Art \(/schools/lcahm/departments/historyofart/index.aspx\)](/schools/lcahm/departments/historyofart/index.aspx), which is located in the renowned Barber Institute of Fine Arts. This houses the Barber Institute gallery – an excellent and representative collection of post-medieval European art that is a valuable and convenient teaching resource for all members to use on a regular basis.
