In July this year she gave a paper on Liszt's symphonic poem *Orpheus* at a conference in Ottawa, in September she went to Briosco in Italy to give a paper on Liszt's tours of the United Kingdom and Ireland, and most recently she spoke about the influence of a Polish actor on Liszt's symphonic poem *Hamlet* at a conference in Budapest.
