

Diverse Birmingham

Birmingham is a modern, industrial city (the second largest in the UK), but religion is one of the most important features of life here.

The city is home to two Christian Cathedrals, and synagogues, mosques, pagodas, temples and gurdwaras from a range of religious traditions – a recent survey by the city council suggests there are well over 600 places of worship in the city. Many of the leaders of these communities have worked with the University of Birmingham and other agencies on a range of interfaith projects in recent years.
