

Philosophy climbs the league table

The department has been ranked 15th in the [Guardian's University guide 2014 \(http://www.guardian.co.uk/education/universityguide\)](http://www.guardian.co.uk/education/universityguide). This is a huge step upwards from the last year's 28th position. According to the Guardian, we have made significant improvements in the overall satisfaction with the course, in the so-called Value-added score which measures the effectiveness of our teaching, and in careers after 6 months. This has helped us to come ahead of the philosophy departments at York, Sheffield, Nottingham, and Reading in the new league table.
