Nuremberg

A group of social work students from the University of Birmingham (UoB), together with a teaching team of academics and service users, recently went on an international exchange to Nuremberg.

During their time in Nuremberg, the Birmingham students joined together with German social work students to take part in professional interdisciplinary discussions and visit community-based projects and statutory social work agencies. Alongside this, the UoB teaching team ran workshops on 'Coping with Counter-Terrorism', Recovery through the Arts and **Service User and Carer Involvement in Social Work Education**.

Rotterdam

In addition to its links with Nuremberg, the Institute have also been developing links with Rotterdam and a group of Dutch social work students will be visiting the University of Birmingham to participate in an Erasmus programme. The programme will include presentations on Juvenile Justice and the UK Riots; Challenging Assumptions when Working with Vulnerable People and Islamophobia.
