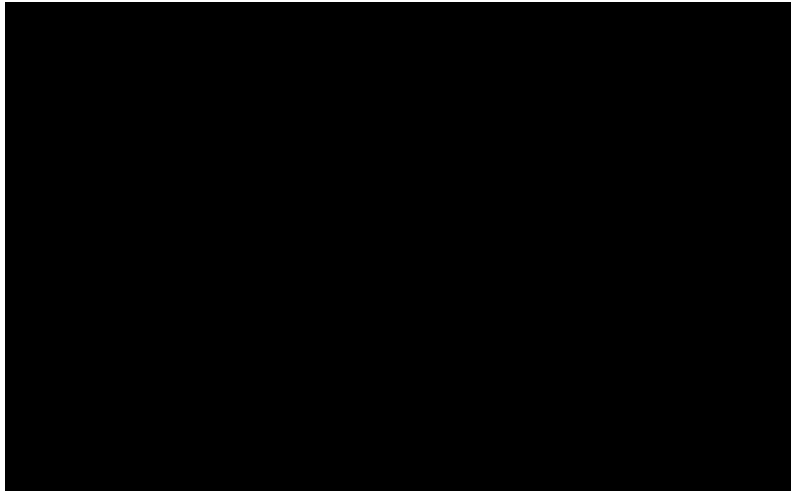
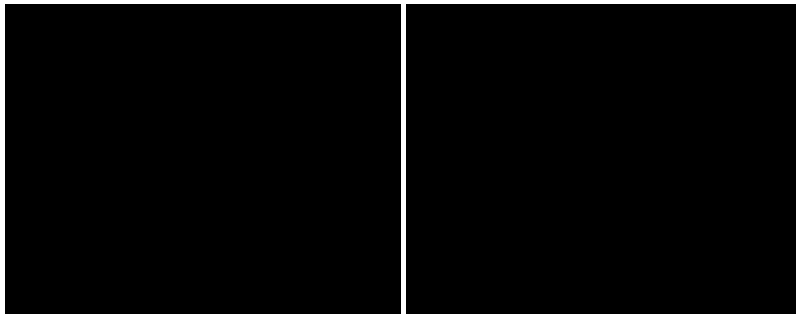


What our students say

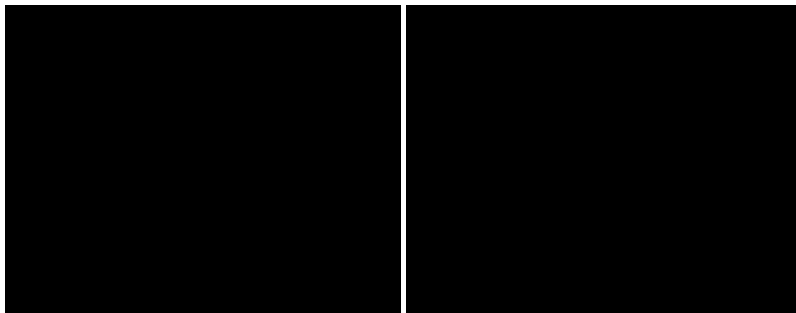
