Biography

I joined the University of Birmingham (UoB) in 1997 as a tutor and examiner on the Distance MA in Translation Studies at the Centre for English Language Studies (CELS now ELAL - English Language & Applied Linguistics). Since 2000, my work has been heavily focused on EAP/ESP at EISU. I have taught on a range of EISU courses, including the multidisciplinary EAP Preessional (2000-2005), and the BME Preessional (2006-). I was appointed BME Director in 2008. In June 2012 and 2013, I led a one-week conference in on English Language Teaching in Kazakhstan. I have also co-represented the UoB on three examining trips to Amirkabir University, Iran.

My in-house publications include materials for the BME Programme, the ELAL distance MA in Translation Studies, Aston University's MBA course and the BScBA Program at the Helsinki School of Economics (now Aalto University), Finland. I also design and deliver online seminars for taught PhD students in the Czech Republic.
