Katie Stant is the Study Coordinator for the SCOOP study (Screening of Older women for Prevention of Fractures). The study (funded by the MRC and ARC) aims to assess whether a community based screening programme for osteoporosis reduces the incidence of fractures in older women in a manner that is cost-effective, and acceptable to women and GPs. In addition Katie is also the Trial Manager on OTCH (A cluster randomised controlled trial of an occupational therapy intervention for residents with stroke living in UK care-homes).
