The weekly prose and translation classes reinforce and develop the skills in years 1 and 2, so as to equip students with the necessary skills to produce accurate and stylish written translations and proeses. Grammar reinforcement activities are blended in. A weekly <i>expression orale</i> class with a native-speaking Assistant Language Tutor (<i>lecteur/lectrice</i>) focuses on oral and aural aspects of the language, and seeks to develop the students' ability to research in the contemporary French press and debate selected French current affairs topics.
