

Campus tours

Our guided campus tours take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 11:00 and 14:00 (BST). Tours are conducted by students currently studying at the University, who will give you an insight into being a student at Birmingham.



Tours last approximately forty five minutes to an hour and include all the main facilities on campus, including the Guild of Students, Munrow Sports Centre and Main Library. The tour will require you to walk round the campus so comfortable footwear is advised. If you, or anyone who will be accompanying you, has a disability or any other special needs please advise us when booking your place. This will allow us to make all the necessary arrangements to ensure your visit is as easy as possible.

Please note that the tours do not include visits to individual departments or halls of residence.

If you wish to visit a particular academic department, please contact the department of interest directly to see if this is possible, but please note this cannot always be guaranteed. All contact details can be found on our website. If it is not possible to visit an academic department, please note that our next Open Days will be held on Friday 26th and Saturday 27th June 2015, when most departments will be open and Admissions Tutors and students will be on hand to answer any queries you may have.

Please note, this is not an automated service and may take up to 48 hours before your confirmation is sent.
