

Undergraduate Open Day

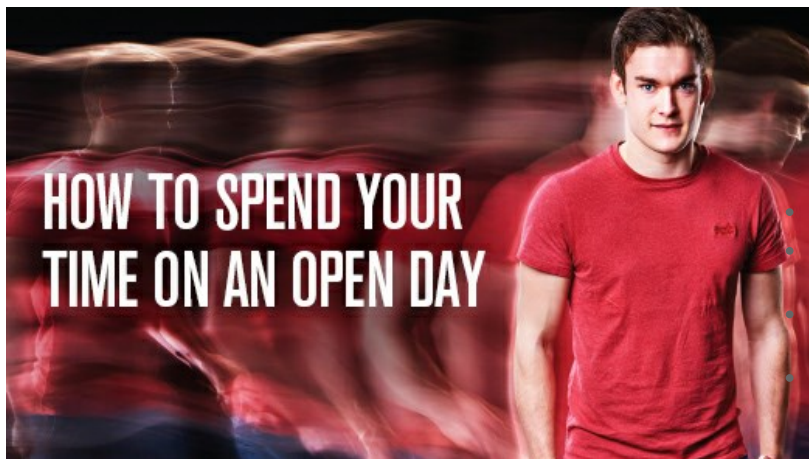
Our undergraduate open days give you the perfect opportunity to hear first-hand from our current students and teaching staff about living and learning at Birmingham.
