The **School of Cancer Sciences** (</schools/cancer/index.aspx>) is one of the world's premier translational cancer research institutes. Underpinned by excellent basic science across the University campus, the School works with many clinical partners to improve the outlook for cancer patients.

The School's portfolio is broad and ranges from leading research in NMR spectroscopy through to large clinical trials that change the standard of care in diseases such as breast cancer. The School includes the first **Cancer Research UK Centre** (<http://aboutus.cancerresearchuk.org/what-we-do/research/research-near-you/birmingham/>) and have been designated as a 'Centre of Excellence' by Leukaemia and Lymphoma Research.
