The number of patients is rising. As social care spending is gradually reduced the healthcare system will buckle under the pressure. We need a solution fast. We need funding for novel accelerated research on dementia. The big UK government pledge to answer "the dementia challenge" is still less than £100 per patient. It is time for the public to become actively engaged and help us to make a difference in dementia research.
