Microsoft Office 365

You now have the option to download the latest version of Microsoft Office for free, as part of the **Office 365 service (<https://intranet.birmingham.ac.uk/it/services/office365/index.aspx>)**, making it easy to use Office on up to five devices.

From August 2014 all Undergraduate and Postgraduate Taught students mailboxes will be upgraded to Office 365 Exchange Online. During this transition student email addresses will change to @student.bham.ac.uk.

my.bham student portal

my.bham (<http://www.my.bham.ac.uk>) is the portal to a wealth of resources for current students and staff. Login once using your central University username and password to have access to your online services, including email, WebCT, tailored news and information to help you in your study. You need to use my.bham to register for your course and to access exam past papers, timetables and results.

Free software downloads

mySoftware (<http://mySoftware.bham.ac.uk>) provides you with a wealth of free site-licensed software from the University. Simply login, select your software and click on the download link.

Laptop clinic

Having a problem with your laptop? For general advice, help with poor performance, access to the wireless network, recovery of lost work (essays or dissertations) or software installation come along to our free Laptop Clinic - part of FixIT, based on the ground floor in the Guild of Students.

Power sockets for laptops
